How to get to Bellingham Court Common Room, Roberts Way, Hatfield AL10 9UW

Your Hatfield GP practice will be running the COVID vaccination centre from Bellingham Court Common Room which is located in the residential area on the University of Hatfield's College Lane campus, Hatfield, Herts AL10 9UW. Details are shown in Appendix 1.

Travel by car

Patients should drive onto the College Lane Campus via Bishops Rise. This is the residential side of the College Lane Campus and is completely separate from the main University entrance. Enter the campus off Bishops Rise to Roberts Way (use the Westgate entrance) marked with yellow arrows on the map) and park in the parking areas immediately nearby. You will see a pedestrian walkway with signpost to the Oval – it is a short walk through to the Bellingham Court Common Room which is next to the Oval and on the opposite side of the Oval from the fountains.

Parking for patients

You can park for a limited time in any of the residential parking areas. Any cars parked for more than 90 minutes will incur a penalty charge. However, if you arrive close to your appointment time you will not be at the vaccination centre for very long.

Disabled patients can use the marked parking bays in the Oval Car park which is next to Bellingham Court Common Room (again use postcode AL10 9UW). Entrance is located off Bishops Rise, and at the roundabout – take the East Gate entrance on to the campus. Turn right onto Roberts Way North and follow the road round to the right for the Oval car park (which is sign posted).

Travel by bus

Uno buses run to College Lane Campus. Bus stops are marked by large purple stars on Appendix 2. The bus stop closest to Bellingham Court is the one located at East Gate entrance. Bus 610 and 653 will take you to either Bus Stop.

For all patients

On arrival please wait outside Bellingham Court Common Room until your appointment time – we have to strictly social distance all patients and you will need to remain on site for 15 minutes post vaccination.

Please wear a mask on entry.

Do not attend for your vaccination if you have any signs of COVID – temperature above 37.8 degrees, new persistant cough or loss of taste and/or smell. **You cannot have the vaccine if you have tested positive in the previous 28 days**. You must notify your practice as soon as you know you cannot attend so that your vaccination slot can be used by another patient.
